- Swipe down on the **Phone** icon or press the **End Call** button.

- Tap the End Call button or press the End Key.

Favorites and Recent Calls:

- You can see your **favorite contacts** and **recent calls** in the Phone app.

5. Sending and Receiving Messages

To Read a Message:

- select a conversation to view messages.

To Send a Message:

- Open the **Messages** app.
- Tap the **Start chat** button.
- Enter a contact or phone number.
- Type your message using the keypad or touchscreen keyboard.
- Tap **Send**.

To Send a Voice Note:

- Press and hold the **Mic icon** to record a voice note, then release and press **Send**.

To Share a Photo:

- Press the **Camera icon** to attach and send a photo.

6. Additional Apps and Tools

- **Gallery:** View, edit, crop, apply filters, and organize images into albums.

- **Camera:** Take photos, toggle flash on/off, tap the screen to focus, and adjust settings for better quality shots.
- **Clock:** Set multiple alarms, add world clocks for different time zones, use timers for countdowns, and access a stopwatch.
- **Musicolet:** A feature-rich offline music player that lets you create playlists, edit metadata tags, add bookmarks, and organize your songs efficiently.
- **ColorNote:** A simple yet powerful notes app where you can create and manage text notes and checklists.
- **Files:** Manage your documents, copy, move, rename, delete files, and access USB storage.
- **Sound Recorder:** Record, save, and manage audio recordings with ease.
- **Calendar:** View upcoming events, add reminders, and set notifications for important dates.
- **Zmanim:** Check Jewish prayer times, set notifications before zmanim, and customize location settings for accurate results.
- **SMS Backup & Restore:** Back up and restore text messages to prevent data loss.

Search Settings:

Connected Devices:

Battery:
